The top two teams will be invited to represent South Dakota in the Pacesetter Great Four-State Championships at the Target Center in Minneapolis.

PACESETTER OPEN

Teams that win in the first round or win .500 or more of their games will be invited to play in the four-state Pacesetter Open in Redwood Falls, Minnesota, on June 4 or June 5.

Pool Play Guidelines

Teams will play each other for one 16-minute period in pool play with stopped time the last one minute. Teams will then be seeded 1-2-3 for the final round of full games. Two timeouts per pool game. No overtimes - tie game ends in tie.
Tiebreakers: 1) Total point differential, 2) Fewer points allowed, 3) Coin flip.

Officials/timers: 16-min. pool game = 1/2 game.
