The champion will be invited to represent North Dakota in the Pacesetter Great Five-State Championships in Minneapolis against the top teams from Minnesota, Wisconsin, Iowa and South Dakota. Any team in this tournament with a strong performance could be selected as a wild card.

Each team in the 8-team Great Five-State championships will play at least one game on the main Target Center floor, home of the WNBA world-champion Minnesota Lynx and the NBA Minnesota Timberwolves.

Pool Play Guidelines

Each team will play each of the other four teams once in an 8-minute pool game with stopped time the final one minute. These games are used to seed the teams and are also helpful for warm up and practice at playing close games in short periods of time. One timeout is allowed. The bonus of two shots will apply on the 4th foul. Teams will then be ranked 1-2-3-4-5 and seeded into the main tournament. No overtimes - tie game will remain a tie. Tiebreakers: 1) head-to-head, 2) total point differential for all four games, 3) fewer points allowed, 4) coin flip.

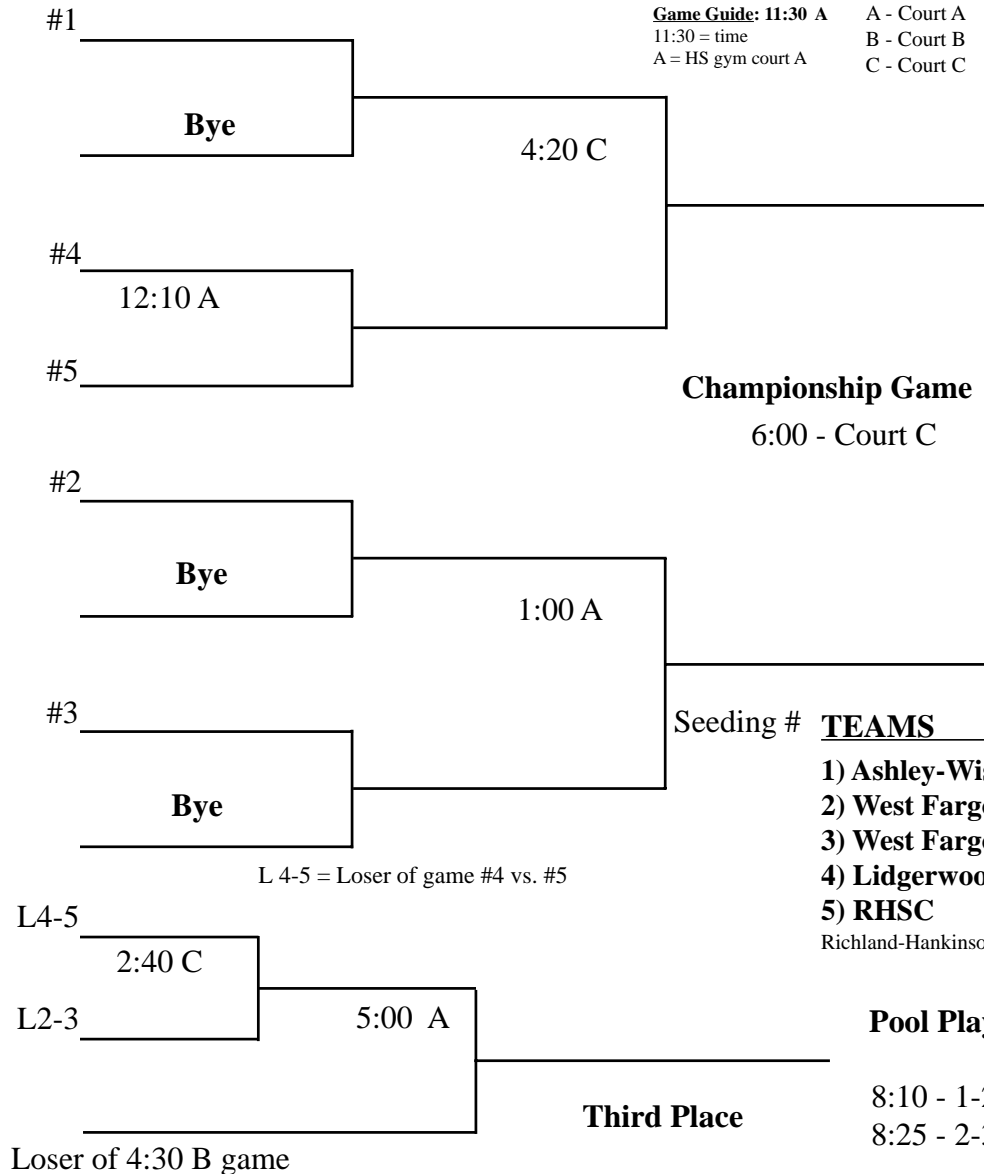
Officials/timers:
