PACESETTER GREAT FIVE-STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS!
Target Center • Minneapolis Fri-Sat, July 14-15

The state champion will be invited to represent South Dakota in the Pacesetter Great Five-State Championships at the Target Center in Minneapolis on Saturday-Sunday, July 14-15, against the top teams from Minnesota, Wisconsin, North Dakota and Iowa. If the champion can not attend, the runner-up team at this tournament will be invited. NOTE: Teams that play well are possible Wild Card selections to the Five-State championship.

Invitations will be provided after the final game. Invited teams should let the Pacesetter staff know their intentions at the tournament, so another team can be invited if needed.

Pool Play Guidelines

Teams will play each other for one 16-minute period in pool play with stopped time the last one minute. Teams will then be seeded 1-2-3 for the final round of full games. One timeout per pool game. No overtimes - tie game ends in tie.
Tiebreakers: 1) Total point differential, 2) Fewer points allowed, 3) Coin flip.

Officials/timers: 16-min. pool game = 1/2 game.

If all three teams finish at 1-1, the total point differential will be used to break the tie.
