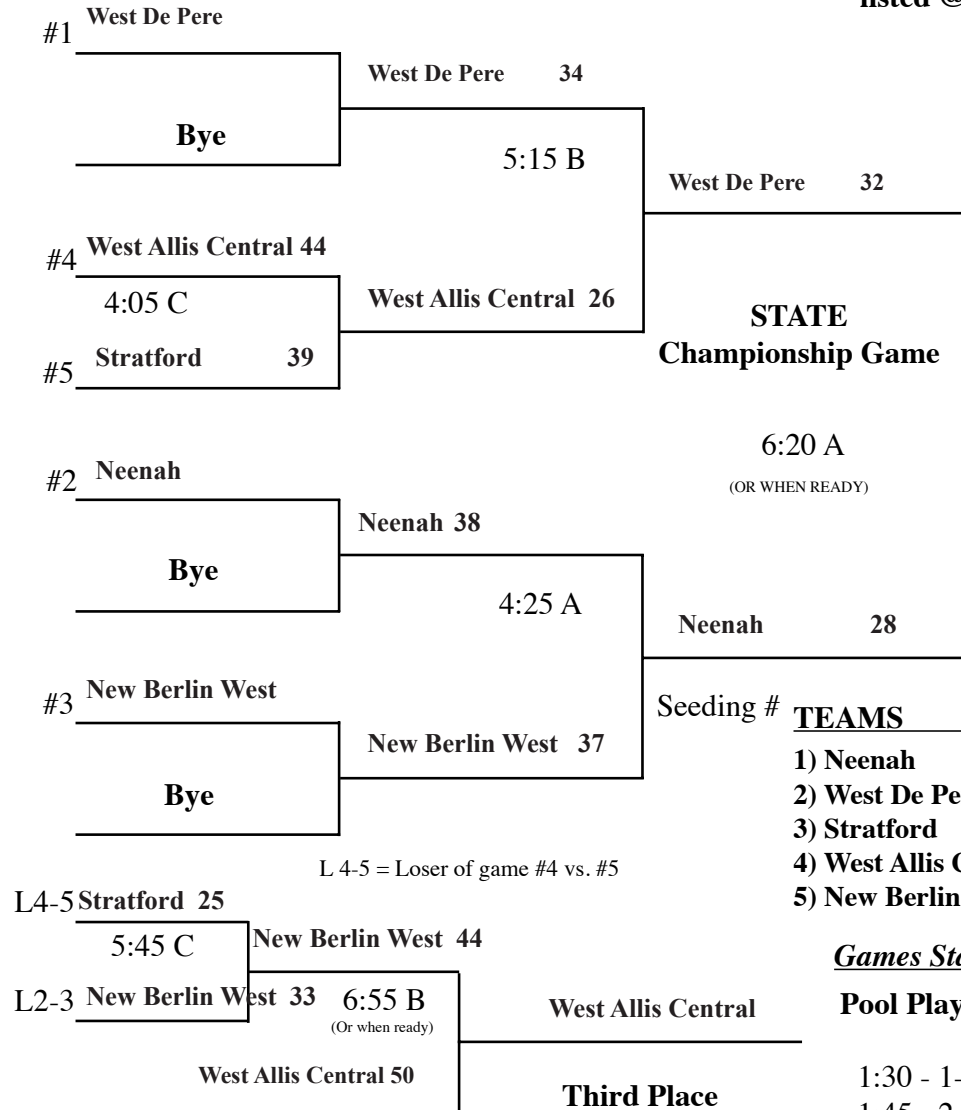

**Post-Season Invitations**

The champion will be invited to represent Wisconsin in the 8-team Pacesetter Great Five-State Championships in Minneapolis, where all teams are guaranteed to play three games with at least one game on the main Target Center floor, home of the T-Wolves and Lynx. Top finishers in the WI state tournament will be candidates for wild card selection to Great State.

**Pool Play Guidelines**

Each team will play each of the other four teams once in an 8-minute pool game with stopped time the final one minute. One timeout is allowed. Bonus of two shots will apply on the 4th foul. Teams will then be ranked 1-2-3-4-5 and seeded into the main tournament. No overtimes - tie game will remain a tie. Tiebreakers: 1) head-to-head, 2) total point differential for all four games, 3) fewer points allowed, 4) coin flip.

Officials/timers: An 8-minute pool game = 1/4 game.
