General Information

Admission

An All-Day pass for 3-4 games is \$10.00 for ADULTS and \$5.00 for STUDENTS K-12. Children who have not yet attended kindergarten are free.

Concessions

Most tournaments will offer a concession stand with food, snacks, and beverages. When schools are providing the concession stand as a fundraiser, no other food or beverages may be brought into the building. Energy drinks and water bottles* are allowed. Please help avoid any embarrassing situations by letting all parents and players know this rule in advance. Please encourage your team to clean up any messes. (*Bottled water is NOT sold at St. Ben's. Bring your own re-usable water bottle. Water filling stations are available.)

No Outside Chairs

Fans should not bring in their own chairs without prior approval due to floor damage concerns and local facility rules. Adequate seating will be available. If you need chairs with a back, please ask the tournament director.

Tournament Format

The tournament format will be determined by the number of teams that are registered and paid on the Monday prior to the tournament. The maximum number for a bracket is 16. The minimum number of teams to conduct a full tournament is 4. With 4-16 teams, a bracket will be created to provide all teams 3-4 games. With 4-6 teams, pool play could be held involving shorter games. With pool play, all teams would be guaranteed the *equivalent* of 3-4 full games. Starting times will be clearly posted. Teams are asked to be at their court 15 minutes prior to game time.

Team Manager

Each team needs to provide a "team manager" to run the scoring table - either to keep the clock or to keep the scoresheet. The two team managers can decide who takes each duty. Team managers will receive a wristband for free admission for the day, which will be provided when the team managers check in at the Coaches' Sign-in table.

Check-in at tournament

All coaches and team managers should check in upon arrival to sign in, turn in your roster, get a packet, and get a wristband. Two coaches and one team manager to assist with scoring per team are allowed free of admission.

Please remember to bring a copy of your online roster and turn in at team check in.

Practice basketballs

Teams **should** bring their own practice basketballs, which are the responsibility of each team.

Game uniforms

Teams should also bring two colors of uniforms in the event teams match the same color. Reversible jerseys are ideal. Numbers on the front and back are required.

Awards

Teams that win their tournament will receive a team plaque. Other top finishers will receive individual medals with neck ribbons.

Team Photo

Teams are encouraged to take a photo by the tournament banner after their last game. Invite parents to join you.

Sportsmanship

Please remind players and fans of the importance of their conduct. There will certainly be judgment calls by the officials that we wish were called another way, especially in a close game, --THAT'S A PART OF BASKETBALL—but everyone is asked to accept that fact of basketball with maturity, setting a good example for the young people on the floor.
